RANGE SAFETY RULES:

(Rev. 7/98)

- 1. THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WILL NOT BE PERMITTED BY ANYONE ON THE GOLDEN TRIANGLE GUN CLUB RANGE AT ANY TIME.**
2. All firearms must be unloaded; slides back and bolts or cylinders open except when firing from the firing line. All firearms on the firing line must have the muzzle pointed downrange. No person permitted downrange until all shooters on firing line have made their firearms safe by unloading and leaving actions open. **DO NOT HANDLE ANY FIREARMS WHILE PEOPLE ARE DOWNRANGE. NO FIREARMS DOWNRANGE AT ANY TIME.**
3. Targets must be placed so that each and every bullet dies harmlessly in the backstop whether shooting at paper or metal targets.
4. Commands by range officers must be obeyed at all times.
5. The firing of all centerfire rifles must be conducted on the 100-yard, 200-meter and higher power rifle ranges only. Black powder rifles or .22 rifles may be fired in practice or competition on designated ranges. Pistols may be fired on the 100-yard range providing all bullets die harmless in the backstop.
6. No climbing or digging on the backstops or side safety walls will be permitted.
7. All firing must be done from the firing line only on all ranges.
8. All Golden Triangle Gun Club rules and NRA safety rules and procedures must be obeyed at all times.
9. Speeds within the Club boundaries must not exceed 10 MPH.
10. METAL TARGETS MAY BE SHOT AT THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES ON THE SILHOUETTE RANGE ONLY.

<u>.22 RIFLE</u>	<u>.22 PISTOL</u>	<u>BIG BORE PISTOL</u>
25 YARDS	25 YARDS	50 METERS
50 YARDS	50 YARDS	100 METERS
75 YARDS	75 YARDS	150 METERS
100 YARDS	100 YARDS	200 METERS

METALLIC TARGETS MAY ALSO BE SHOT ON THE 50-YARD PISTOL RANGE AS LONG AS THE METAL TARGETS ARE PLACED AT 50 YARDS. RIFLES AND PISTOLS MAY BE SHOT AT METALLIC TARGETS ON THE 100-YARD RANGE AS LONG AS THE METAL TARGETS ARE PLACED AT 100 YARDS. DO NOT SHOOT RIFLES AT THE SWINGERS ON THE SILHOUETTE RANGE.

GENERAL CLUB RULES:

1. The Golden Triangle Gun Club will meet at dates and times to be announced. Watch for your newsletter. Also, you will be notified of any change of time or place of meeting.
2. Club dues are \$40.00 per year with a \$40.00 initiation fee for new members. Dues must be paid in advance on or before September 1st of each year. The combination to the gate changes on Sept. 1st of each year. Each member must maintain membership in the National Rifle Association.
3. Any member who gives the gate combination to persons other than club members in good standing shall immediately lose his/her membership with NO chance of reinstatement. Any member found guilty of mutilating or stealing club property shall immediately lose his/her membership and be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.
4. Any dependent in a club member's immediate family may accompany the club member to the range at any time.
5. A member may take one guest to the range for a maximum of three (3) times only. After the third visit to the range, this guest is requested to join the Club. This guest must be under the member's supervision at all times and the member will be responsible for his actions.
6. The hours for shooting on the range are from daylight to dark. The exception will be IDPA sanctioned Matches with 10 PM the latest shooting time.
7. At no time will trash shooting be permitted anywhere on the range. This includes tin cans, glass containers, ammo boxes, etc., and/or other types of trash.
8. Do not use standard target frames for patterning shotguns. Use specified marked area and shotgun target frames only. Unserviceable target frames should be removed from target house and placed on trash pile. All other trash should be put in trash receptacles provided or taken home. It is the duty of every member to help keep the range facilities clean.
9. Only one (1) target frame per shooter if range is crowded (50% of shooting benches being used).
10. Anyone wishing to start a new shooting program must contact the Board of Directors for approval.
11. Physical or verbal abuse or destruction of club property or persons will not be tolerated. Discourteous acts will not be allowed. All members and guests must use common sense, courtesy and safety. It is the duty of each member to call these rules to the attention of any violator and to ask that he/she abide by these rules and regulations. Be courteous-not abusive. If the violator continues to disregard the rules, call this to the attention of the members present and inform the club President of the names(s) of the violator and all witnesses. Abusive behaviour will not be tolerated by anyone.
12. The firing of handheld or shoulder type firearms are permitted on the appropriate ranges. The firing of carriage, spade or tripod-mounted firearms will not be permitted. The use of any firearm capable of firing any type of explosive or incendiary projectile will not be permitted. **FIRING OF ANY FIREARM CAPABLE OF FULL AUTOMATIC FIRE OR BURST FIRE WILL NOT PERMITTED.**
13. All members must have their membership card on their person while at the range. Also, decals should be affixed to the car window; however, this does not substitute for the membership card.
